Clifford Antone (born October 27, 1949, Port Arthur, Texas - died May 23, 2006, Austin, Texas) was the founder of a well-known Austin blues club, record label, and a mentor to Stevie Ray Vaughan, Jimmie Vaughan and numerous other musicians. Antone moved to Austin in 1968 and attended The University of Texas at Austin. An arrest for marijuana led to his dropping out of school. Nurturing a passion for Chicago blues, Antone started a blues club at age 25. The club, Antone s, became one of the first music venues on Austin s 6th Street and helped lead to Austin s reputation as a music city. Clifton Chenier, Fats Domino, John Lee Hooker, Delbert McClinton, Pinetop Perkins, Muddy Waters, Albert Collins, Jimmy Reed, Clarence Gatemouth Brown, B.B. King and many other famous blues musicians have performed at Antone s in its more than 30-year history.
