The first of these provides for the unification of the six units of the University into a single educational system with unified budgetary control and administration. The second recommends, a clarification and definition of the powers of the State Board of Education. The past experience of the Board supplies many examples of the difficulties under which the Board functions when it has responsibility for the control of higher education but is without authority to carry out the responsibility. Time and again the lack of unity in the educational structure itself, the fiscal independence of the individual institutions and the lack of budgetary control have hampered the Board in its efforts to administer the system of higher education with wisdom and efficiency.
