Sir William Hunter may be allowed in the words of the preface to the first edition to tell the aims of his book: In this book I try to exhibit the growth of the Indian peoples, to show what part they have played in the world s progress, and what sufferings they have endured from other nations. Short Indian histories, as written by Englishmen, usually dismiss the first two...
