His father and grandfather both bore the name of Joseph Strong, and were Congregational ministers, descended from Elder John Strong of Northampton, whose descendants, generally worthy of their Puritan ancestry, are scattered all over the land, and often found, as they have ever been, occupying positions of trust and responsibility. One of them is at this moment an honored associate of my own on the bench of the Supreme Court, being in the same degree of descent as the subject of this memoir, -...
